The production on Monday and the two following nights was "The Speckled Band." It was well and effectively staged and ably acted. Harry Lionel made an excellent Sherlock Holmes, and John Haddleton well sustained the character of Dr. Eyclott. Maud Lambert, as Euid Stonor, was charming, and other parts by Jessie Jones, Olga Jefferson, Charlie Parker, Nana Davey, Chas. Lester, E. Holme-Cheatley, and Nadan Finnes were cleverly taken.




Louis again demonstrates his versatility. He gives a powerful rendering of Sherlock Holmes. Hamilton Langham is very interesting throughout as Dr. Watson. Courtney Robinson impresses in the rôle of Professor Moriarty. Harry Benson and Madge Trevelyan are convincing as the Larrabees. Harry J. Clifford is excellent as John Farman. Gladys Ford Howitt is much admired in her impersonation of Alice Faulkner. Betty Booth is effective as Billy, as also are Florrie Hall as Parsons and Helen Adam as Terese. Douglas Ives makes the most of Sidney Prince. Next week "Bella Donna" will be staged.


Mr. Joseph Millane himself proved the scene in the best of us for his really excellent portrayal of the rashly Rylott, while Mr. Raymond Lovell makes a perfect Sherlock Holmes—in looks, words and deeds—according to the author's original conception of that wonderful man. A well-restrained performance is given by Miss Patricia McNab, who has the onerous part of Eddie Stone, the terrorised, and yet self-possessed, surviving step-daughter of Dr. Rylott. Dr. Watson comes to life in the hands of Mr. Charles M. Julian, and Miss Bala Karsough is delightful as Lily, page to Sherlock Holmes. Mrs. Stanton, Rylott's house-keeper and semi-accomplice in his crime, is the part entrusted to Miss Alice Greenwood, and she carries out her rôle with distinction. Lesser important characters are portrayed by the other members of the company, and the play also introduces a few local faces, who appear in the first act as a coroner's jury.

"The Speckled Band" is the best of the four good plays so far presented by Mr. Millane and his colleagues, and those who like a first class mystery play presented in a most commendable manner should attend the Grand other to-night or to-morrow.





Throughout *Dawson and Friends*, jazz musician **Humphrey Lyttelton** appears as **Sherlock Holmes** to Dawson's Watson, and has a similar effect to John Cleese's tall, patrician presence in the earlier *Sez Les* shows. There were other similarities, more noticeable off-screen. 'We used to call them the Odd Couples, because Les hit it off immediately with John Cleese, and the great Lyttelton,' Barry Cryer observes. 'They hit it off straight away. Lyttelton loved Les Dawson.'
